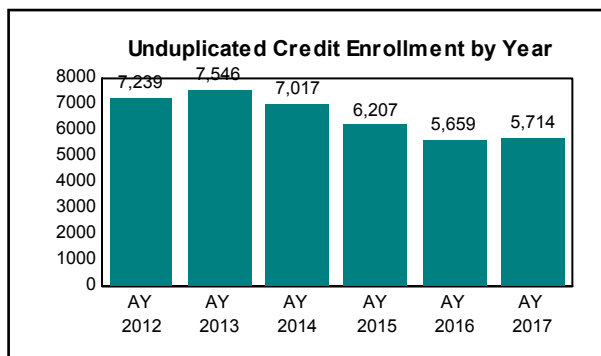

## Enrollment

(Based on Academic Year 2017 credit enrollment.)

**Atlanta Tech's Main Campus in Fulton County enrolled 5,714 students** in credit courses during Academic Year 2017. This was the Full Time Equivalent (FTE) of 3,143 students (based on the sum of total credit hours for all students).

The **five year percent change** in credit enrollment, from AY 2012 to AY 2017 = **-21.1%**

**High School students** enrolled at Atlanta Tech's Main Campus: **343**

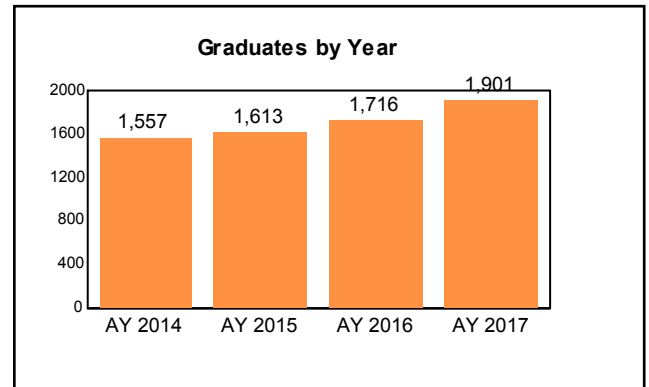

### Graduates

(Based on Academic Year 2017 graduates.)

Workforce development is a key mission of Georgia's technical college system. **An unduplicated total of 1,901 graduates** received awards from this institution in Academic Year 2017.

The **three year percent change** in graduates, from AY 2014 to AY 2017 = **22.1%**
