



Need money for college in 2022-2023?

Fill out the Free Application for Federal Student Aid (FAFSA) to qualify for grants (free money!), work-study jobs, and low-interest government loans. If you want financial aid, you must complete the FAFSA.

Set aside about 30 to 45 minutes to complete the FAFSA.

Simplify the process by having certain information ready. Here's what to gather or know ahead:

- Your Social Security number.
- Tax records – you may be able to import some tax data using the IRS data retrieval tool on the FAFSA site.
- For the 2022-2023 FAFSA, use 2020 tax information.
- Your Federal Student Aid Identification Number (FSA ID), which is needed to sign the application electronically.
- Parental information including tax records and FSA ID (if the FAFSA determines you are a dependent student).
- Use Atlanta Technical College school code **008543**. Your FAFSA data will be sent to us.
