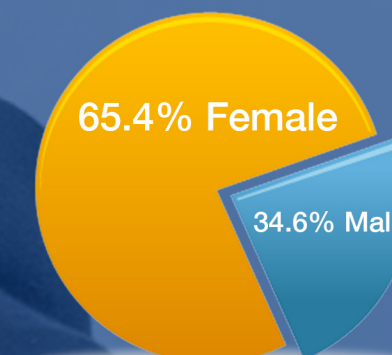

ATC partnered with Generation, one of the world's largest youth employment organizations, to deliver their first Cloud Support Engineer training program in the U.S. The 12-week program was designed to provide cloud computing training and career opportunities for young adults between the ages of 18-29.

Participants had the opportunity to earn their Amazon Web Services (AWS) Cloud Practitioner certification.

ATC was the host site for the seventh year for the Horizon Atlanta Technical College Summer Enrichment Program, the only Horizon's program held at a technical college. We served over 100 rising 1st through 7th grade children from the community.

ATC partnered with the Super Bowl Host Committee to provide services on Super Bowl Sunday for over 2,000 half-time show volunteers.



•The college was selected to partner with USA Global Education Services and the Checkpoint Charlie Foundation to host eight teachers from the German state of Saxony for a professional development program.

• Barbering student, Alexander Burke-Johnson, is completing a job shadowing program in Germany working with the Herz Foundation.

•We've partnered with City of Atlanta to create the Center for Workforce Innovation, a groundbreaking educational model that is sponsored by Delta Air Lines, Georgia Power, The Home Depot, Intercontinental Exchange, and SunTrust.

•We held the 2nd Annual Dr. Brenda Watts-Jones Lecture series to raise breast cancer awareness.



•The Aspen Institute College Excellence Program named Atlanta Technical College as one of 150 community colleges eligible to compete for the \$1 million Aspen Prize for Community College Excellence.

•We've received a \$3.7 million Tech Hire grant to prepare students for employment in high-growth industries.
