Brenau University and Atlanta Technical College**


The following list of courses offered by Atlanta Technical College (ATC) will be accepted as transfer credit to Brenau University (BU) for the corresponding Brenau courses in all Bachelor of Science in Education degree programs.

Other college transfer courses accredited as such by the Southern Association of Colleges and Schools Commission on Colleges (SACSCOC) may also be presented on a case-by-case basis for evaluation as transfer credit to Brenau University. This list is not all-inclusive and should be reviewed periodically by the registrars of ATC and BU and updated to reflect changes in the curriculum at either institution. The agreement will remain in effect until the vice president of academic affairs at either institution gives notice that the agreement should be discontinued at the end of the semester in which such notice is communicated in writing.
