Appointment Sequence:

1st Appointment:

Oral Health Screening (OHS)

(Determines your oral health status. OHS are free and walk-in basis only.)

2nd Appointment:

Radiographs (x-rays)

Bring recent xrays from another provider with you.

3rd-5th Appointment:

Depending on your oral health you may need one of the following types of cleanings:

- Prophylaxis with fluoride
(for healthy gums and teeth)
- Non-surgical Periodontal therapy
(for diseased gums and teeth may require multiple appts)

All new patients require minimum of 2 appointments
